

SUMMER PARKING in SUNAPEE HARBOR and GEORGES MILLS HARBOR



Dear Visitor to Sunapee -

Sunapee welcomes visitors all year round, but especially in the summer. We have a beautiful lake for swimming, boating and fishing. All visitors to Sunapee should enjoy their time here and leave Sunapee saying, “What a great place.” Here are some helpful hints about parking in Sunapee during the busy summer months:

There is **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING** allowed in any parking area including any lot designated for boat trailer parking unless permission has been granted by the landowner.

If you are bringing your boat to launch in Sunapee Harbor, please follow the “Boat Launch Route” signs. Once your boat is launched, you can park your vehicle and trailer in one of the following lots designated for trailer parking:

River Road/High Street gravel lot -available 7 days a week;

Route 103B—Sunapee Town Office parking lot (available WEEKENDS ONLY); or

Sherburne Gym lot—can be used 7 days a week when school is NOT in session.

These are the ONLY 3 lots for boat trailer parking in Sunapee Harbor. If you park anywhere else, you will receive a ticket and/or be towed.

If you are visiting the harbor without a boat, please park in the parking areas provided in the harbor for vehicle parking. Please do not park along any road or street unless otherwise posted. Also note that some lots are limited to 2 hours and some to 4. If you park along a roadway or in a lot that is privately owned, you will receive a ticket and/or be towed.

These parking rules apply to Georges Mills Harbor as well. There is ample signage in both harbor areas to direct you to where you can or cannot park.

Are you planning to relax on the beach or go swimming? Sunapee has 2 town beaches - Dewey Beach and Georges Mills Beach. These beaches are for Sunapee residents only and their guests. Sunapee residents obtain beach permits (stickers) at the Sunapee Town Office and can obtain additional permits for their guests and visitors. The permit **MUST** be placed in or on your vehicle in a place easily seen by anyone. The town beaches **ARE** checked on a regular basis for beach permits. If you are parked in either beach parking lot and your town permit / guest permit **IS NOT VISIBLE**, you will receive a ticket and/or be towed.

We don't want to give out parking tickets. It is both tedious and time-consuming for us, not to mention how unpleasant it is for you. Please read the signage posted at all of our town lots. We want you to enjoy your stay here in Sunapee and return often.
