PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE

All defendants in criminal cases are presumed to be innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

On May 11th, 2024 at approximately 18:34 hours, Sergeant Nicholas Boisvert received a request from the Newbury Police Department to assist them in locating a vehicle that appeared to have fled from them while one of their officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop. Sgt. Boisvert responded to the area of the traffic circle at Mount Sunapee in Newbury and subsequently observed the reported vehicle traveling westbound on Route 103 with an expired inspection sticker. After obtaining authorization to operate in Newbury from Newbury PD, Sgt. Boisvert activated his blue lights and stopped the vehicle on Route 103B in Newbury just before the Sunapee town line.

The vehicle operator was identified as:

Cesar Suarez Llosa (57) of Weare, NH

Upon running SUAREZ LLOSA's information, Sgt. Boisvert learned that he was a habitual offender in the State of New Hampshire since December of 2022. SUAREZ LLOSA was then placed under arrest and charged with Operating After Certification as a Habitual Offender, contrary to NH RSA 262:23; which is a Class B Felony, and Uninspected Vehicle, contrary to NH RSA 266:5; which is a violation-level offense.

SUAREZ LLOSA was transported to the Sunapee Police Department for booking and processing per department policy, then bailed and released on personal recognizance with an arraignment date of July 2nd, 2024 at the 5th Circuit Court in Newport, NH.

PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE

All defendants in criminal cases are presumed to be innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

On May 11th, 2024 at approximately 21:15 hours, Officer Nicholas Henault observed a vehicle with a headlight out traveling westbound on Route 11 near Central Street. Ofc. Henault activated his blue lights and stopped the vehicle near Sugar River Bank.

The vehicle operator was identified as:
Dennis Hoisington (42) of Grantham, NH

Upon running HOISINGTON's information, Ofc. Henault learned that HOISINGTON's license was suspended and that he was previously convicted for Driving After Suspension in 2018. HOISINGTON was also required by the New Hampshire Department of Motor Vehicles to have an Alcohol Ignition Interlock device on any motor vehicle under his operation; which he did not have installed at the time of this traffic stop. Subsequently, HOISINGTON was placed under arrest and charged with Driving After Revocation or Suspension (Subsequent), contrary to NH RSA 263:64(VI); which is a Class B Misdemeanor, and Alcohol Ignition Interlock Circumvention, contrary to NH RSA 265-A:37(I); which is a Class A Misdemeanor.

HOISINGTON was transported to the Sunapee Police Department for booking and processing per department policy, then bailed and released on personal recognizance with an arraignment date of July 2nd, 2024 at the 5th Circuit Court in Newport, NH.

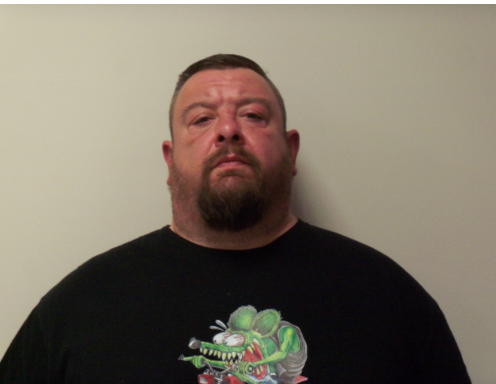

PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE

All defendants in criminal cases are presumed to be innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

On May 13th, 2024 at approximately 10:27 hours, Officer Cooper Dion was patrolling Route 103B as part of a Highway Safety grant patrol targeting child seat restraint violations when he observed a vehicle on radar traveling northbound at 45-MPH in a 35-MPH zone. Ofc. Dion turned around and stopped the vehicle near Oakledge.

The vehicle operator was identified as:

Upon running SPIKER's information, Ofc. Dion learned that SPIKER's license was suspended resulting from a previous DUI conviction. SPIKER was subsequently placed under arrest and charged with Driving After Revocation or Suspension (DUI), contrary to NH RSA 263:64(IV); which is a Class A Misdemeanor.

He was transported to the Sunapee Police Department for booking and processing per department policy, then bailed and released on personal recognizance with an arraignment date of July 2nd, 2024 at the 5th Circuit Court in Newport, NH.

PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE

Ofc. Merullo soon learned that MENARD had fled to Dollar General in Newport. Newport PD and Newbury PD were able to locate him at Dollar General and subsequently transported him back to the scene. After speaking with MENARD, Ofc. Merullo placed him under arrest and charged him with Domestic Violence-Simple Assault, contrary to NH RSA 631:2-B,I(A); which is a Class A Misdemeanor.

MENARD was transported to the Sunapee Police Department for booking and processing per department policy, then bailed and released on personal recognizance with an arraignment date of May 21st, 2024 at the 5th Circuit Court in Newport, NH.
