Cliff reported on the inquiry regarding the Wendall Marsh Vernal Pool Study that was done privately by Michael Simpson . The owner is willing to sell to us. Cliff will inquire on the "asking price". We could pay but the question is how much as our budget not large. This document would be a nice study to have on the parcel for comparison purposes, species identified. Also important report to have is the Sunapee Springs paperwork, well info. All existing documentation on any parcel is vital to the Forest Management report and important to have it all in on central location or at least referenced and where one can locate additional documents.

Tim Fleury attended the ABC and Selectman meeting on behalf of the SCC. All went well. A couple general questions.

Van will inquire with Donna where the SCC ended up on the Capital Reserve funding for the SCC for 2019.

Lela will inquire with Lynn at the TOS the last week of December for a year end accounting and a start of year prediction/final tally of our balances.

SCC will meet Wednesday, January 2, 2019

Jerry, Cliff and Clayton Platt blazed and painted ½ of the sewer plant trail (west side) from the Treatment plant to Ryder Corner. 2.4 miles. The paint is red. The group hopes to finish the parcel boundaries the next week.

Tim reported that all the pins are set on Ski Tow Hill and Ryan is planning on attending our January Meeting with a report and update on work done. Penny Royal Hill will submit a bill for expenses/supplies for the project. SCC should also expect a bill from Penny Royal Hill for the blazing and painting of the Wendall March Trail work.

SCC members will use the completed Forestry Management guidelines for planning to get started on the work to be done parcel by parcel in priority order. The first priority will be to paint and blaze property boundaries on all parcels. The first to be done is the Bartlett Tyler parcel. The next priority will be addressing invasive species, parcel by parcel, specie by species, case by case. Cliff has volunteered to start working on the blazing/painting of boundaries. Van will email Laura Meadowsend Timberlands LTD to get direction and boundary location identifiers to make sure ok and only re-blaze where obvious and get guidance where not clearly marked. Another item to address per the report planned for spring 2019 will be parking on Garnet Hill start work after road postings cleared. Following that a Timber Sale in the winter on Ledge Pond parcel.

Lela will contact Andy Deegan with ASLPT for the easement for Wendall Marsh and Ledgepond.
Lela will contact Donna Nashawaty regarding inquiry on 911 indicators for town property for emergency needs on a trail, also ask about TOS boundary markers, and inquire on Wendall Marsh/Sunapee Springs documents.
