Recreation Committee Membership- Current committee structure is made up of 8 people, 7 voting members and 1 alternate. Currently there is a vacancy for 1 alternate.

Update from Scott-

- Dewy field shed was broken into but nothing was taken.
- Scott has ordered wooden token which he'd like to be handed out for good deeds by the kids. Each token is worth \$.25 at dewy beach. Motion was made to accept Scotts recommendation. Motion passes.
- Scott asked the board to review the program fees so that we can discuss potential changes at next meeting.
