

**Town of Sunapee: Recreation Committee
Meeting Minutes for February 11, 2020**

- **1 Policy Update took place during this meeting (highlighted). No votes took place**

1) Fitness Trail Update

- a. Celia spoke with the gym teachers, the town manager, some community members as well as the conservation commission to gather information
- b. It was determined that the land space where the fitness trail would be located is not conservation land (the land at Tilton Park).
- c. Celia was instructed by the town manager to get her proposal together for the March 23rd board of selectmen meeting
- d. Charleen stated that all the land that they are looking at is all Town of Sunapee land according to the tax map. The trail could be designed multiple different ways

2) Basketball Update

- a. Regular season is over.
