2. APPOINTMENTS:**7:00-Chief John Galloway, Formal Request to Accept Fire Boat Donation; Transfer of Ownership from Sunapee Fire Fighters Association to Town of Sunapee Fire Department**

- Chief Galloway began the conversation by asking the Selectboard to accept the Fire Boat donation. Selectboard member Gallup asked if this was a new boat or the same one the department has been using. Chief Galloway explained the boat is a newly donated boat. It was built specifically for Sunapee Fire Department. Chair Wallace asked where the boat would be docked. Chief Galloway hoped that they could use the other side of the police

dock. The 'old boat' will remain in use. It will deploy to smaller water bodies if needed. Scott Hazelton clarified that the current permit for the police dock does not allow two boats. The permit would need to be amended to allow both boats to be docked. Chief Galloway asked if the boat could, temporarily, dock at the town dock while the permit issue is being modified. Selectboard member Gallup noted that two separate actions needed to be taken: (1) accept the donation and (2) permission given to use the town dock.

- Selectboard member Trow highlighted that since the boat is over \$5,000, the Town needs to hold a public hearing to accept unanticipated funds. Selectboard member Gallup suggested the selectboard vote to give permission to the Sunapee Fire Department Association to use the town dock. Vice Chair Gottling asked if Chief Galloway had spoken with Police Chief Cobb. Town Manager Martinez stated that the Police Chief was in full support.

Selectboard member Trow made a motion to allow the Sunapee Fire Department Association to use the town dock, Selectboard member Gallup seconded. All voted in favor.

The public hearing is tentatively scheduled for the next meeting, May 15 at 7:00PM.

- Chief Galloway reported on the bids received for the sale of the department's F550. The highest bid was \$11,000. Once the full administrative process has taken place, Chief Galloway would like to use the monies to purchase new equipment.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- Chair Wallace clarified that when she became chair, she changed public comment from five minutes to three minutes.
- Lynn Arnold, 22 Burma Road, stated her group has consulted three different lawyers. Each lawyer categorically stated the Selectboard did not have the authority to make the decision that they made at their last meeting. Before legal action is taken against the town, she would like the Selectboard to reconsider their decision.
- Joan Puchtler expressed concerns over the Selectboard's decision to allow short-term, transient occupancies to continue to operate. In her opinion, the Selectboard does not have the authority to take decisions on land use matters. She asked the selectboard to reconsider its decision.
- Jamie Silverstein, joined by Peter White, Joe Butler, Jeff Claus, shared that the ZBA and Planning boards implore the Selectboard to reverse their decision from last meeting. Both the Planning Board and the Zoning Board will collaborate with the Selectboard to meet their obligations and support the public's vote. She stated that they expect that as a selectboard they are committed to supporting the popular vote in town. Both the Planning Board and the ZBA request a joint meeting with the Selectboard to discuss this matter further. Ms. Silverstein emphasized the support of the Zoning Board to assist the Selectboard should they reverse their decision.
- Robin Saunders, Burma Road, expressed concern that the selectboard did not have authority to make such a decision. She reminded that the board are elected officials. She would like the board to reconsider their decision.
- John Augustine, Nutting Road, would like confirmation concerning the new highway director's use of a town truck to go to and from work. He was not provided with a response at the last meeting. Are the taxpayers paying for the gas? Do other town employees get the same perk? Separately, Mr. Augustine would like to understand more about the business manager position. Is this a new position? Is it costing the town more money?
- Chris Whitehouse, Winn Hill Road, commended selectboard member Gallup for abstaining from the Avery Road CZC in accordance with the code of ethics. Mr. Whitehouse commented on the process at his employer regarding the personal use of work vehicles. He continued to explain that he felt the board correctly delivered their enforcement decision regarding STRs. Mr. Whitehouse commented on the right-to-know regarding Dewey Woods.
- Ann Bordeianu, Maple Street, is a resident and representative of the Short-Term Rental Taskforce. She is concerned by the decision delivered by the selectboard to allow STRs to bypass the special exception process.
- Lisa Hoekstra, Maple Street, asked if the selectboard met with counsel prior to delivering a decision. Chair Wallace clarified it was a non-meeting with counsel. Ms. Hoekstra asked if the decision of the selectboard was based on the information provided by the attorney. Ms. Hoekstra asked if they had been/ or if there will be a public hearing regarding the fee structure. Chair Wallace responded yes.

- Christine Corey requested the Selectboard to allow additional time for public comment. She recommended the board return to allowing five minutes. Chair Wallace encouraged residents to succinctly formulate their thoughts within the allocated three minutes. She also recommended residents submit questions in advance of the meeting so that the selectboard has time to obtain the information necessary to properly answer the question. Ms. Corey continued by expressing concerns about the amount of work involved with processing STRs through a process that may not be necessitated, recommending that the implementation of the adopted ordinance be withheld until next year.
- Hope Damon, State Representative, reported that there were currently 93 bills with the house education committee-all in various stages. She explained that she was newly appointed to the committee on housing. State Representative Damon shared that the budget that was approved by a voice vote will now change through the Senate. She continued that a bill has been submitted regarding small businesses and passed, awaiting to be signed by the Governor. State Representative Damon commended the board on their meeting accessibility both online and streaming.
- Peter White, Stagecoach Road, clarified that legacy is not a term recognized by the selectboard. He continued that STRs were not previously considered Tourist Homes.

4. SELECTMEN ACTION:

 - The Fenton Family explained that they needed the space to paint the boat. They continued by explaining that this boat is smaller and more manageable, expecting to need 7 days weather dependent. The Chief of Police requested fencing to surround the project site. Mr. Fenton confirmed that a fence will be in place.

5. TOWN MANAGER REPORTS:

- **Public Comment**
 - A short discussion about public comment helped clarify Chair Wallace's expectations. Wallace would like to see residents submit questions in advance of the meeting, allowing time for people to prepare a thoughtful answer. If not given in advance, a question could be tabled and addressed under old business at the next selectboard meeting. Selectboard member Trow commented that yes or no questions can be addressed on the spot; however, dialogue should be limited and addressed at a later date. Selectboard member Gallup suggested that if residents had a matter of importance, they make an appointment to discuss with the selectboard inclusive of providing enough information beforehand allowing the board time to contemplate the matter. Vice Chair Gottling felt that yes and no questions should be addressed immediately. Chair Wallace

summarized: everyone should address yes/no questions; longer answers and/or matters needing more research should be addressed under old business.

Town Manager Martinez confirmed that the new Highway Director is using a town truck to go/from work. The previous two Highway Directors were afforded the use of a truck to ensure timely patrols.

She continued by explaining that the business manager position has moved from the finance department to the highway department. It is not a new position nor is it a new cost to the budget. It was approved in the budget.

Town Manager Martinez, in response to a resident's comment, noted that documents missing from the meeting minutes, was not intentional.

- **Clayton Platt: Goshen/Sunapee Town Line Monument, Brook Road**

- The request is to set one bound on Brook Road as shown on the maps sent and staked on the west side of the road. The Goshen Board of Selectmen agreed to have Clayton set the marker.

Motion made by Selectboard member Gallup, seconded by Selectboard member Trow. All voted in favor.

Selectboard member Gallup spoke to previous markers that had not been permanent which highlights the need to set the markers every seven years.

- **Expenditure/Revenue Reports**

- Town Manager Martinez explained that current budget projections show that we will be approximately \$100,000 underspent at year end. With that in mind, we've earmarked monies to cover legal expenses. Based on current spending, we are going to add an additional \$45,000 to cover the supreme court case.

In analyzing the budget, several line items are not being drawn down nor have they been in recent years. As budget season fast approaches, we will be discussing these line items with the Department Heads.

- **Permission to issue Boston Cane; Ceremony to Follow**

- Prior to leaving, Barb spent a fair amount of time trying to determine who should receive the Boston Cane. She identified the individual she suspected was the oldest living resident in Sunapee. We have since been contacted by one family member who we believe is related to the oldest person in Sunapee.
- Selectboard member Gallup explained that the original cane is in the case in the lobby of Town Hall. The replica is issued to the individual. Selectboard member Trow stated that this should be treated as an achievement and celebration.

Motion made by Selectboard member Gallup, seconded by Selectboard member Trow. All voted in favor.

- **GovOS Update-Scheduled to Roll out in June 2023**

- Town Manager Martinez highlighted that the registration process very closely mirrors the ordinance. From her perspective, community members writ large potentially do not understand that the registration process is intended for ALL short-term rentals--regardless of zones, must register and comply with the registration process.
- Vice Chair Gottling advised the Selectboard to hold a public hearing to then determine if a second hearing would be necessary. Town Manager Martinez asked if opening the document to

comment online would help to streamline the process? Selectboard member Trow asked if the draft process was close to being finalized. Town Manager Martinez noted that it is very close to being final. The team has a few outstanding questions for the Selectboard: inspections, fire pits, and fireworks. Selectboard member Trow recommended a draft version be prepared for the board to review at the new meeting. Thereafter, the form could go online for comments prior to the first public hearing (as a second would be held if necessary). The public hearing will be held after Memorial Day.

- Code Compliance Officer, Craig Heino, started today, May 1, 2023.

- **OpenGov Update-Scheduled to Roll out in June 2023**

- Town Manager Martinez shared that this system would allow residents greater access to information and will allow them to process permits in a much more streamlined fashion. Town Manager Martinez highlighted that this program will be piloted prior to going live to address any issues.

- **ARPA Annual Reporting Submitted**

- As required, our annual ARPA report was submitted. Included, you will find an up-to-date accounting of funds. Funds must be fully obligated by 31 Dec 2024 and expended by 31 Dec 2026. Remaining balance to be obligated: \$129,052.86.

- Town Manager Martinez referenced Trask Brook Road included in the documents with the agenda packet.

- **Right to Know: Dewy Woods**

- Parking is within the Town's Right Away; Parking fine money goes into the general fund. Reasonable to allocate monies to Rec Revolving and earmark for Dewy Wood maintenance?
- Town Manager Martinez spoke to the assessment of the right of ways, demonstrating that nothing being done is illegal as far as she can ascertain. Selectboard member Gallup stated that historic deeds could clarify the width of the right-of-way.

6. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

- Selectboard member Gallup thanked fellow board members for showing up and for working alongside one another. He commented on the lawsuits that have been threatened and the hard decisions that the board is required to make in the best interest of the town. Selectboard member Gallup feels disrespected by some of the comments made at the meetings regarding the difficult decisions that come before the board. Chair Wallace commended the board's ability to continue working with one another even under disagreements.
- Chair Wallace asked the board if there is a need to reconsider the STR decision. Selectboard member Trow answered that this would not be necessary, and that the registration process will be applied to everyone regardless of the decision made at the last meeting. Town Manager Martinez clarified that the decision made relates to an enforcement issue, not a land use issue.

Motion to reconsider determination of pre-existing short-term rentals made by Chair Wallace, seconded by Selectboard member Gallup. Chair Wallace voted in favor. Vice Chair Gottling, Selectboard member Trow, and Selectboard member Gallup opposed.

Chair Wallace highlighted that the zoning and planning board representatives attended the meeting and expressed their willingness to partner with the Selectboard and to carry the workload. Town Manager Martinez asked if the board wanted to consider processing the applications in batches. Selectboard member Gallup felt that this would not be feasible to accommodate and would require too many meetings for the land use board. And we would still miss the critical deadlines and then they would be approved by default. Selectboard member Trow reiterated his interpretation of conversations prior to the vote was that pre-existing transient accommodations would be permitted.

- Chair Wallace brought the idea proposed by community members wanting a dog park. Selectboard member Trow noted that dog parks require a vast amount of open space. Town Manager Martinez highlighted that the space requested was Dewey Woods in front of Mount Royal. Discussion continued. Board members welcomed the conversation to be brought to the board from the interested community group.

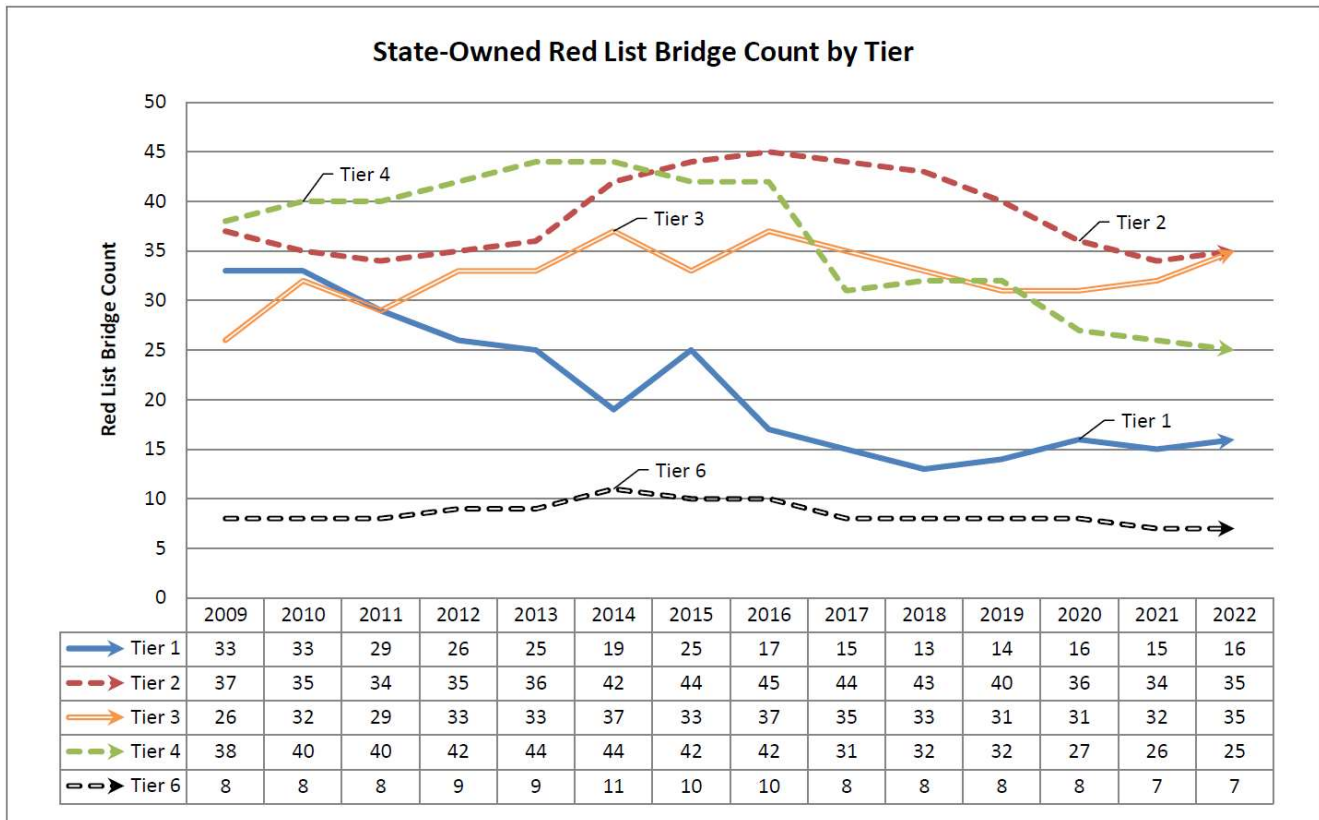

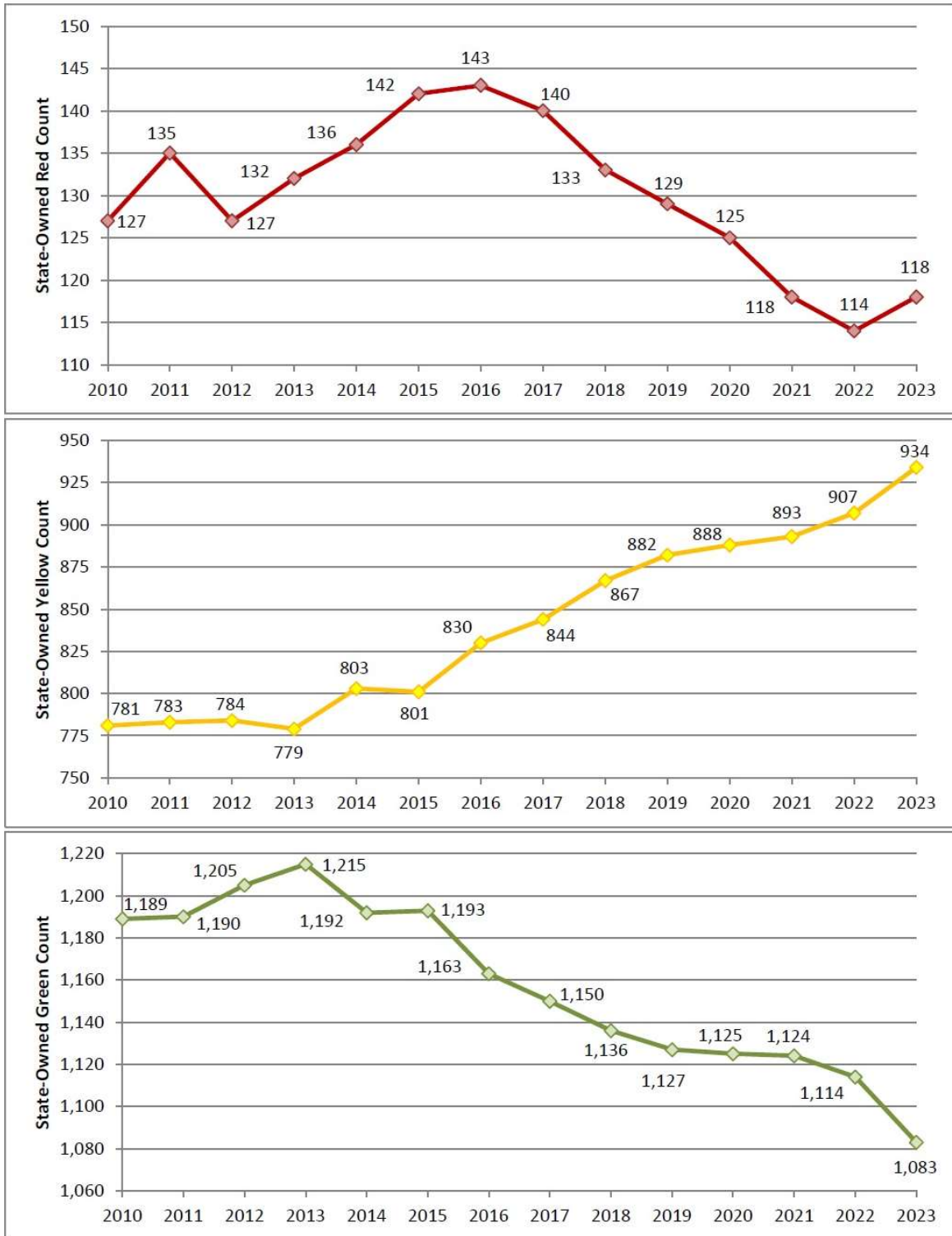

2022 State Red List Bridge Summary Key

The Bridge State Red List is comprised of state-owned bridges requiring interim inspections due to poor condition. These state bridges are inspected twice per year.

Definitions of the column headings used in the Bridge State Red List are listed below:

1. 2022 Priority From Ranking Sheet – This is the current year bridge priority number for the specific bridge. This category can also be “Under Construction”, for bridges that have already had construction begun by Bridge Maintenance or have been advertised by Bridge Design.
2. 2021 Priority From Ranking Sheet – This is the previous year bridge priority number for the specific bridge. A blank in this field indicates that the bridge was not on the red list in the prior year.
3. Town / City (Project Name) – The Town or City where a bridge is located. If the bridge spans between two Cities or Towns, both are listed. (Project Name included if the bridge has a specific, publicly known, local name or dedication name).
4. Bridge Number – The six-digit bridge number assigned by the Bureau of Bridge Design to identify each structure uniquely within a specific Town or City.
5. Owner – The entity responsible for maintenance of the bridge (NHDOT, NHDRED, Turnpike Bureau of NHDOT, NHDES, and IBA).
6. State Project No. – If a bridge has an assigned State project number, it is listed here. You will also see the following in this column:
 - a. BOBM = Bureau of Bridge Maintenance is responsible for addressing the bridge.
 - b. BORT = Bureau of Rail & Transit is responsible for addressing the bridge.
 - c. NHDES = New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services is responsible for addressing.
7. Facility Carried – This is the roadway or rail line carried by the bridge.
8. Feature Crossed – This is the roadway, waterbody, or rail line crossed by the bridge.
9. Year Added to Red List – The year the bridge was added to the Red List.
10. Roadway Tier (carried by the bridge) – NHDOT-defined categorization of state roadways based on their relative importance to the overall state transportation network. The tiers and corresponding bridges are noted below:
 - Tier 1 – Bridges carrying Interstates, Turnpikes, and Divided Highways
 - Tier 2 – Bridges carrying Arterials: US Routes and some State Numbered Routes

 - Tier 4 – Bridges carrying Local Connectors and some State Numbered Routes
 - Tier 5 – Municipally Owned Bridges

11. ADT-Year – Estimated Average Daily Traffic with the corresponding year of the estimate.

12. 2023-2032 10-Year Plan – This column shows the status of the project within the specified Ten-Year Plan period.

- Year = Year the bridge is in the referenced 10-Year Plan
- Bridge Maintenance = Bureau of Bridge Maintenance will complete
- Not Included = The bridge is not listed in the referenced 10-Year Plan period.
- Prior Plan = The bridge is included in a year prior to the referenced 10-Year Plan.

13. Condition of Deck, Superstructure, Substructure, or Culvert – In accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS), each major structural element (deck, superstructure, or substructure; or culvert) of a bridge is rated according to its condition. In addition, AASHTO has developed recommended color ratings for bridges to indicate their overall general condition.

“9 = Excellent”	(Green)
“8 = Very Good”	(Green)
“7 = Good”	(Green)
“6 = Satisfactory”	(Yellow)
“5 = Fair”	(Yellow)

17. Bridge Posting – Current bridge weight posting. “NPR” indicates no posting required.

18. Structure Type – Using NH Bridge Type abbreviations, the type of bridge structure is noted (see next page for descriptions).

19. Year Modified / Year Built – The year of the most recent major rehabilitation effort and the original year of construction.

Municipal Red List Bridge Summary Key

The Bridge Municipal Red List is comprised of municipally-owned bridges requiring interim inspections due to poor condition. These municipal bridges are inspected once per year.

Definitions of the column headings used in the Bridge Municipal Red List are listed below:

1. Town / City – The Town or City where a bridge is located. If the bridge spans between two Cities or Towns, both are listed.
2. Bridge Number – The six-digit bridge number assigned by the Bureau of Bridge Design to identify each structure uniquely within each Town or City.
3. Facility Carried – This is the roadway or rail line carried by the bridge.
4. Facility Crossed – This is the roadway, waterbody, or rail line crossed by the bridge.
5. Est. ADT (Year) – Approximated Average Daily Traffic with the year for which the traffic was estimated.
6. Condition of Deck, Superstructure, Substructure, or Culvert – In accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS), each major structural element (deck, superstructure, or substructure; or culvert) of a bridge is rated according to its condition. In addition, AASHTO has developed recommended color ratings for bridges to indicate their overall general condition.

“6 = Satisfactory”	(Yellow)
“5 = Fair”	(Yellow)

Note: When a bridge has one or more major structural elements with a condition rating of “4 = Poor” or less, it is categorized as structurally deficient and is added to the Red List.

7. Total Length (ft); Total Width (ft); No. of Spans – Bridge specific information about width and length of bridge to compute deck area.
8. Gross Deck Area (sf) – Multiplication of bridge length times bridge width to develop a bridge deck area. Culverts use the approach roadway width for this calculation as the width of the structure is coded as “zero” within the NBI data.

9. Date of Most Recent Inspection – Actual date that the last field inspection was completed.
10. Bridge Posting – Current bridge posting if required.
11. Structure Type – Using NH Bridge Type abbreviations, the type of bridge structure is noted.
12. Year Modified / Year Built – The year of the most recent major rehabilitation effort and the original year of construction.

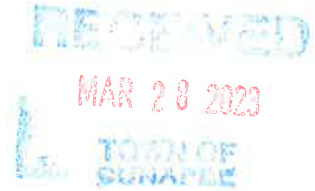

Re: Goshen/Sunapee Town Line Monument, Brook Road

Dear Board Members:

I am writing on behalf of Michael Mayo regarding the town line along and thru his property on Brook Road. I recently surveyed the Robillard property on both sides of Brook Road, located in Goshen and Sunapee. I spent quite a bit of time looking for the monument along Brook Road that is referenced in past perambulations. I could not find it. The Robillard's did not recall ever seeing it. Other surveyors who have worked in this area have not recovered any monuments on either side of the road.

Mr. Mayo recently purchased all the Robillard property in Sunapee and Goshen on the west side of the road. He also acquired the land on the east side of the road located in Sunapee, while the Robillards kept the land in Goshen. This has highlighted the importance of having a certain town line location, marked by a bound on Brook Road. I am confident as to where the town line crosses Brook Road based on other town line markers I have located and other surveys in the area. However, in the end, the exact location of the town line is up to the Selectmen or their representatives.

I am including a copy of my survey for the Robillards and a copy of a survey for Mr. Mayo by Clifford Richer. I have recently set a stake on the west side of the road in the location where I believe the Town Line crosses. This is approximately on line with a straight line from the jog at the wall to the east and a pipe by the brook to the west (+/- a couple feet). We would like to set a formal bound at this stake with the approval of both Towns. The good news is that Mike has agreed to pay for a scribed granite bound and I will set the bound at no cost to any town or taxpayer. I will also provide a sketch of the location of the entire Goshen/Sunapee town line based on survey work done over the last 10 years. Presumably when the next perambulation is done, this could be incorporated into the official record. If desired, I also have a copy of a document that was used in the 1990's to certify a new bound set on the Sunapee/Croydon town line.

Please feel free to contact me with any questions. I have sent identical letters to both Towns and we are hoping that we can move forward with this in the near future.

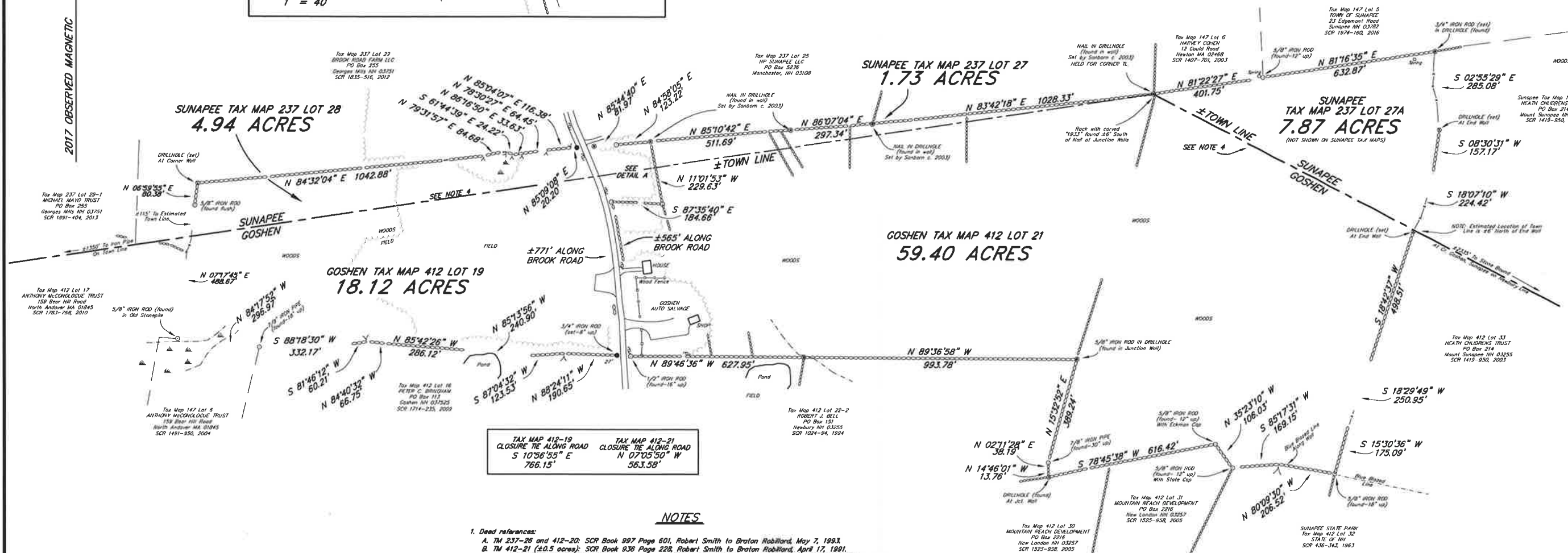
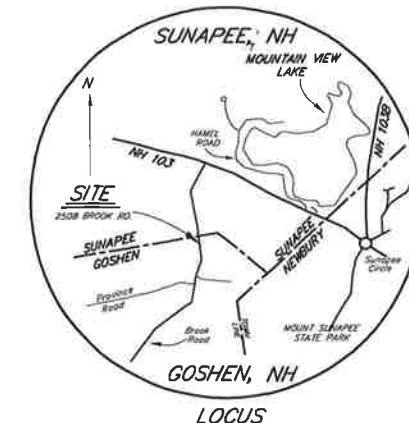
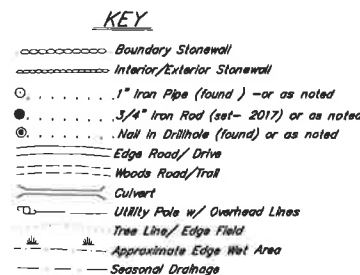
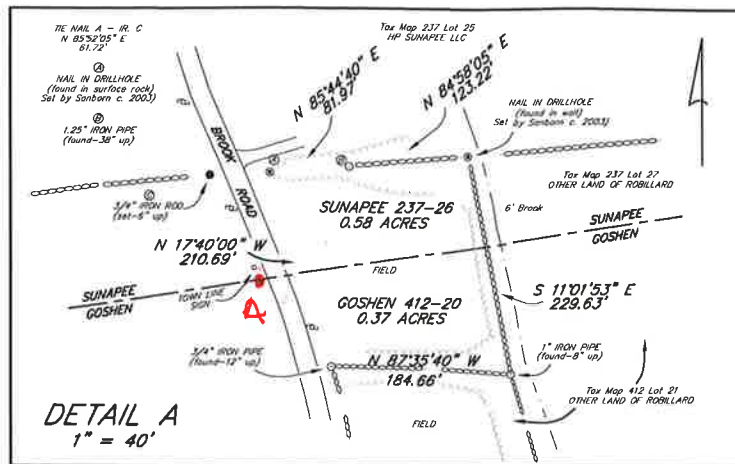

On the 8th day of November, 2009, the undersigned met to perambulate the town line between New London and Sunapee. All markers were located and GPS readings were taken. We have also included the previous directions

Bound #1

Beginning at the northwest corner of New London and the northeast corner of Sunapee by a stake and stone near a large yellow birch tree marked TL , NL and S. Most visible dates include 1887, 1904, 1911 and 1974.

(Marker is about 150 feet northerly of the concrete marker placed by the state on I -89 to indicate the town line. Because of a small swamp, it is necessary to enter the woods using the private driveway to Hemp Hill.....permission required.... and continue on towards the power line. Enter the woods as the power line starts up the hill, and walk down toward the swamp. The birch tree is now dead.) Birch has fallen on ground and largely disappeared. Stone monument is lying on ground and barely visible/readable. A new monument has been place at this site. New monument is a 3 foot tall iron pipe with T.L. on the cap.

Thence South 24 degrees West for 850 feet to a large round boulder on the shore of Lake Sunapee. Marker is a flat rock next to this boulder with vertical face facing Lake Sunapee. Rock is marked TL on the lake side. Most visible dates include 1887 . 1904, 1911 , 1918, 1925 , 1953, and 1960 .

(Boulder and adjacent flat rock are near two tall pines on the shore just before the workshop building on the property of Lincoln Gordon.) Access is from Lake Ave in Georges Mills. Go east to the end of road. Private driveway for Lincoln Gordon is straight ahead. Town line is next the workshop. Proceed down steep slope. Marker is very difficult to see/read from land.

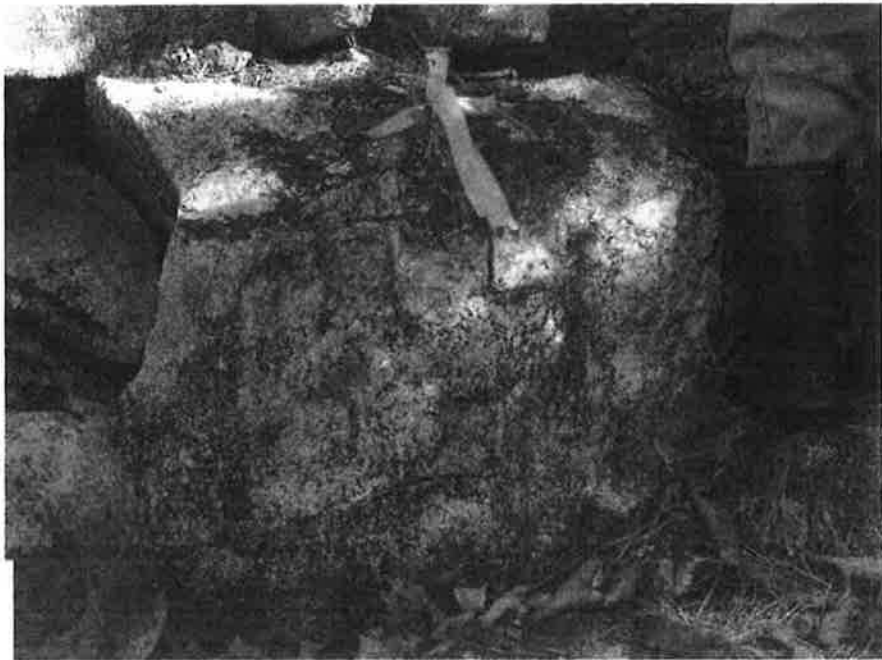
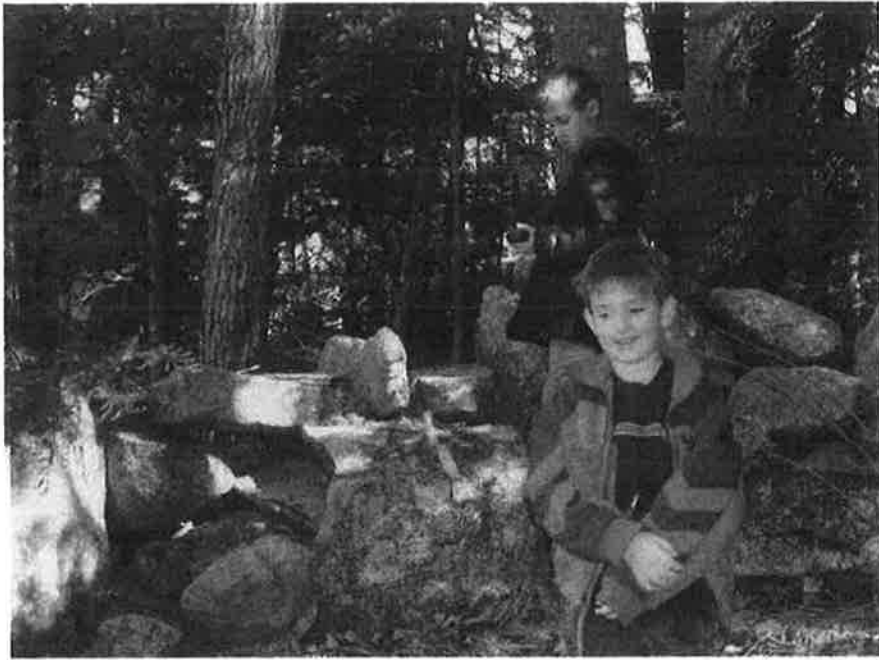

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To the Sunapee Selectboard,

Although disappointed and frustrated that the countless hours spent by numerous individuals and boards developing and crafting an ordinance, that was approved by the voters, will never be applied to existing Short-Term Rentals (STR's) as a result of your actions, it is reassuring that the registration process will still provide some level of protection for our neighborhoods and residents.

It would be helpful if the language in the registration form either align with the Zoning Ordinance or it simply refers to the Ordinance for needed definitions, to avoid any inconsistency and confusion.

Also, as a requirement to meeting the "pre-existing" status, the proof of paying state rooms and meals tax should be dated prior to December 01, 2022, and not after, to avoid current STR's trying to pay in arrears in order to meet the criteria.

Finally, the definitions that were adopted into the Ordinance as part of the amendment clearly defines which use may hold special functions, such as weddings, meetings, or other gatherings. Please make sure that this is made clear in the registration form as well to help the town minimize any uncertainty and conflict.

I would ask that this email be entered as part of the public record for your next scheduled meeting.

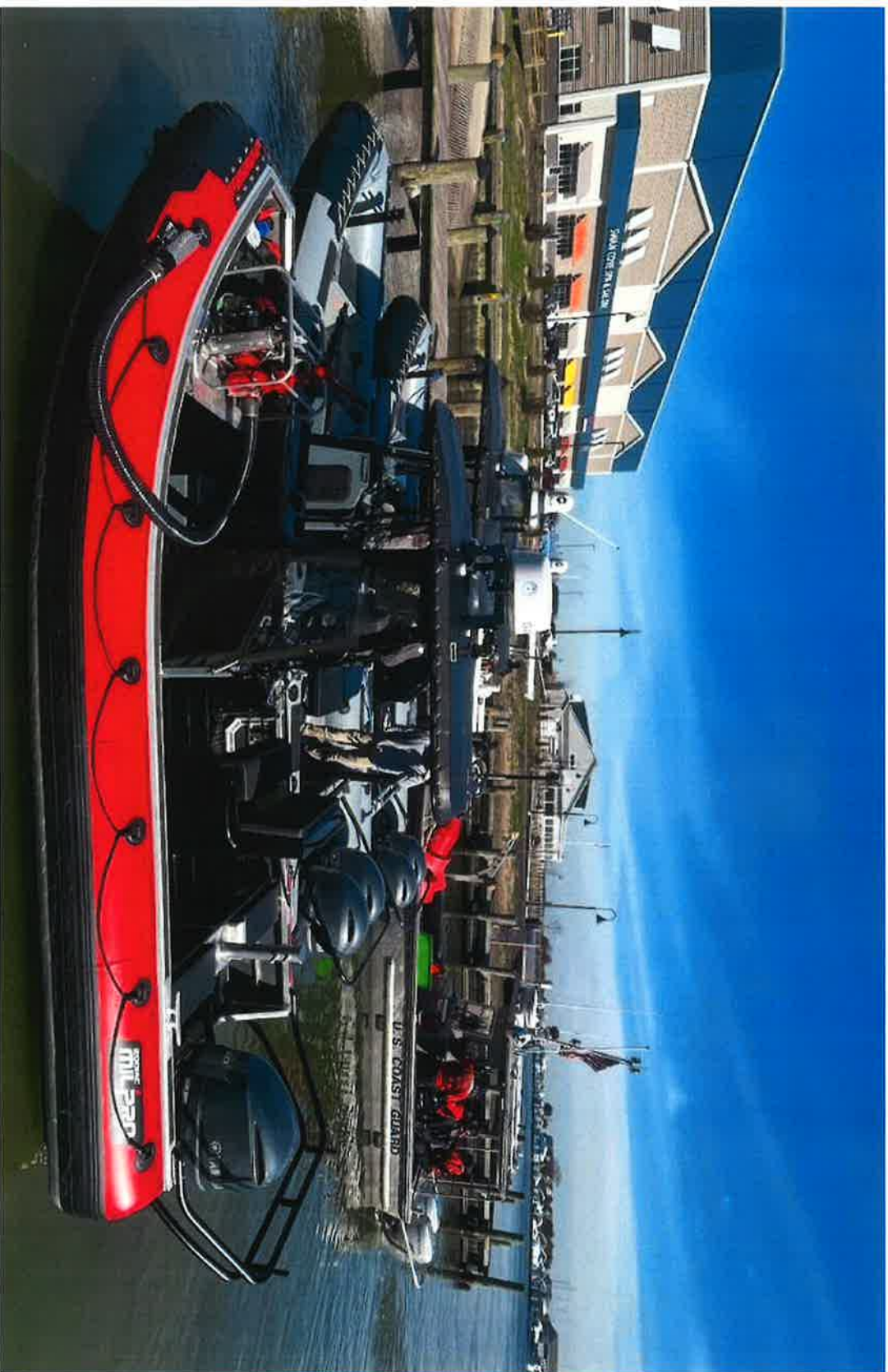
