Board of Commissioners Meeting February 27, 2020 Sunapee Town Office Meeting Room

PRESENT: Theodore Gallup-Chairman, Jimmy Williams, Richard Curtis, Douglas Gamsby,

Jeffrey Reed.

Also present: David Bailey and Holly Leonard.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.

1. Forms for Signing:

January 30, 2020 Meeting Minutes: Douglas G. made a motion to accept the Commission Meeting Minutes of January 30, 2020, seconded by Jimmy W., Douglas G. suggested that GZA should reflect Geo Environmental in order to avoid having just the acronym in the records, voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman. February 12, 2020 Wendell Well Informative Session Minutes: Douglas G. made a motion to accept the minutes of the Wendell Wells Information Session of February 12, 2020, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>January Sewer Purchase Journal:</u> Jimmy W. made a motion to accept the Sewer Purchase Journal as written, seconded by Douglas G., after some discussion regarding Aries Chemicals and Maher Corporation, voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>January Water Purchase Journal</u>: Jimmy W. made a motion to accept the Water Journal for January as presented, seconded by Douglas G., after some discussion regarding Underwood Engineers, voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

1st Additional Sewer Billing Warrant: There was some discussion regarding the property in question and what is being done there. Douglas G. made a motion to approve the Billing Warrant, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

2. Water Treatment Highlights: Dave B. reported that the second filter has been cleaned and that the February TTHM testing result had come back as a 53 but the yearly average was still barely violating. Dave B. stated that there had been a water main break on Springfield Road yesterday and that it had started sometime Tuesday and was found yesterday. Dave B. stated that he has been looking into doing something with the cable company for phone and internet service at both Harbor Hill and the Wastewater Treatment Plant and that in order to get the cable run there would be a need to run conduit for the cable company to use but that this would not happen until warmer weather.

3. Water Emergency Plans: Dave B. reported that he had changed the shut-down procedure for Sunapee to reflect more current information. Douglas G. questioned if Pizza Chef, Dunkin Donuts and the Smokehouse should be on the priority notification list. There was some discussion regarding Pizza Chef not being on the Town water system and that Slavin's Haven was going off the system soon if not already. It was decided that Dunkin Donuts and the Smokehouse should be added to the priority notification list for Sunapee. Jimmy W. questioned if the turbine was still operational, Dave B. stated that it is used whenever possible and would be utilized in case of emergency loss of power. Douglas G. made a motion to accept the emergency plans for Georges Mills and Sunapee as amended, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

4. Wastewater Treatment Highlights:

Dave B. reported that the plant has been running pretty decent up until today with the excess water from the rain causing issues with the clarifiers. He stated that he will be stopping in to check on them when he leaves as there has been issues with the depth of the sludge blankets being inconsistent and that he thinks that it may be caused by rags built up on something that is causing the issue. Dave B. reported that the new polymer experimentation is looking promising for the phosphorus removal although it seems to involve extra labor and the resulting sludge is wetter than what was being achieved before. He stated that there had been a contractor that stopped in at the plant and he had been given a quote from him for sealing the chlorine contact tank in the amount of \$15,700 per side. He stated that he will be getting a few more quotes but thinks that the tank needs some rehabbing. There was some discussion regarding different options for dealing with the aging contact tank and what is causing the deterioration of it. Dave B. stated that he has received another contract for spraying of the phragmites and that he plans to enter into it for treatment in September.

Dave B. reported that there have been some issues with one of the new pumps at Pump Station #9 making a lot of racket and that it seems to be due to a bad bearing and so one of them is being rehabbed. He stated that KSB is working on it and that he thinks one of the pumps at Pump Station #10 may also have a similar problem. He reported that it has been noted that one of the pumps at Woodland Road Pump Station has been running more than the other one and that perhaps it needs rehabbing or replacement. He stated that it will cost approximately \$10,000 for a new Meyers pump and that until he finds out what is going on with the new pumps he is leaning toward what was originally installed. Dave B. stated that he will have this purchase in mind for the end of the year in hopes of having funds in the budget to purchase one.

Jimmy W. questioned how the phosphorus levels were leaving the plant and Dave B. responded that they seem to be good but that there are some spikes at certain times during normal operations. There was some discussion regarding the experimentation with phosphorus removal and other Towns having similar issues.

5. Old & New Business:

Dave B. presented that he has been going back and forth with Mike Metcalf about getting automatic valves installed at Harbor Hill during the Ultraviolet light installation and that Mike M. had given a quote of an extra \$12,200 for engineering of these valves. There was some discussion regarding the funding for the project and if the warrant article would pass or not. Jeffrey R. made a motion to approve the engineering agreement contingent upon the approval of the warrant article, seconded by Jimmy W. after some discussion regarding what was going to be installed, voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>Hydrant Fees:</u> There was some discussion regarding January's vote to set the hydrant fees at \$220 a year supposing to have been \$250 per year (a 25% increase). Douglas G. made a motion to increase the hydrant fee for 2020 by 25%, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 26, 2020.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Sunapee's Drinking Water Contains High Levels of Disinfection By-Products

NOTICE OF STANDARD MAXIMUM CONTAMINANT LEVEL (MCL) VIOLATION

The Sunapee water system has been in violation of drinking water standards for total Trihalomethanes (TTHMs) for all of 2018 and 2019. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what is happening, what you should do and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. The Locational Running Annual Average (LRAA) is determined by averaging all the samples collected at a particular monitoring location during the previous four calendar quarters. The LRAA standard for Total TTHM is 0.080 mg/L. Although the individual result for the 4th quarter of 2019 was a .064 mg/L for TTHM and the result for the 1st quarter of 2020 was .053 mg/L, when calculating the LRAA the Sunapee system still was in exceedance of the maximum contaminant level for TTHM.

The LRAA of TTHM exceeded the MCL of 0.080 mg/L at our system's sampling location.
The LRAA was0.0807 mg/L

What does this mean?

This is not an emergency. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However, some people who drink water containing trihalomethanes in excess of the MCL over many years may experience problems with their liver, kidney or central nervous system and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What should I do?

It is not necessary to use alternate water; however, if you have specific health concerns, please contact your health care professional. General health related questions may be directed to Dave Gordon of the NHDES Environmental Health Program at (603) 271-4608.

Steps We Are Taking: The Sunapee Water & Sewer Commission's consultant is finishing up the final design for installation of an Ultraviolet Disinfection System to be installed at the Sunapee Slow Sand Filter Plant. This system has been chosen as the best alternative to help curb the formation of TTHM's. The Commission will present the final design to the NH DES for their approval and then begin construction as quickly as possible. The Commission is pleased that the warrant article for the funding of said design and construction on the March ballot has passed and the project is fully underway.

We had anticipated resolving the problem within the first six months but have been unsuccessful in resolving it with the small procedural changes that were tried. We are, however, anticipating the problem will be resolved by December of next year.
