New London/Sunapee Water & Sewer Commission Joint Quarterly Meeting July 29, 2021 Sunapee Town Offices Meeting Room

PRESENT: Theodore Gallup - Chairman, Douglas Gamsby, Richard Curtis, Charles Hirshberg, Jeffrey Reed, Jimmy Williams, Wayne Stoddard.

Also present: Holly Leonard, David Bailey, Kimberly Hallquist-New London Town Administrator, New London Selectmen-Nancy Rollins, Janet Kidder and John Cannon. April Sargent & Charley Hanson-R.M.I.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.:

- 1. <u>April 29, 2021 Joint Meeting Minutes:</u> Douglas G. made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 29th joint quarterly meeting, seconded by Nancy R., Sunapee polled in favor, New London polled in favor, so declared by the Chairman.
- 2. R.M.I. SHINCCI Sludge Drying Unit Presentation: Charley H. and April S. gave a presentation on the merits and effectiveness of the SHINCCI heat pump, sludge drying unit that has been used at Bellows Falls and Hookset. There was some discussion regarding the future of biosolid disposal and the benefits of having a dryer ending product. Wayne S. questioned what type of longevity the drying unit has as well as how much maintenance it would require, Charley H. replied that the unit has a 20-year life span and gave some ideas about the amount of maintenance that should be done. Nancy R. questioned what the cost of this unit might be, Charley H. responded that with everything included it would be less than \$250,000 for a unit sized correctly for Sunapee's use and that it would be about 13.5 feet long by 7.5 feet wide and high. There was some discussion regarding the space available in the current building and what other items may be needed for the operation of the unit. Charles H. questioned what type of warranty the unit would have, Charley H. replied that it has a one-year warranty and that can be added to for a cost. Charley H. stated that there would need to be more information put together to get a firmer number on what the total cost of the unit would be. R.M.I. departed at 6:20 p.m.
- 3. Wastewater Treatment Highlights: Dave B. reported that they have been working with the rare earth at the plant and that it seems to be working well in keeping the phosphorus numbers consistently low. He stated that the rain has been causing an ongoing battle with the processes at the plant and that it has been difficult to remain in compliance. He stated that there had been one e-coli violation early in the month but that had been the only one. Dave B. told the boards that last week they had put flow into ditch number two to handle the high flows and this had cut the volume in half and made a huge difference in the ability of the plant to process the large amounts of water. He stated that when things calm down with the amounts of flows that they will take ditch number one offline for cleaning and having available to use in the event of future high flows. Dave B. stated that he still is having issues with the phone lines and internet at the treatment plant and presented that the current lines are buried and have been problematic for years. He is proposing running some conduit and

putting it in so that cable can be run to the plant. Dave B. stated that Anthony D. from N.H. DES wants to come sample different places to see if it can be determined where the PFOA's may be coming from. He stated that he is planning to test some locations in Sunapee and would like New London's cooperation with testing there as well. New London agreed that this is necessary and Dave B. stated that it would be done every couple of months at various manholes.

Dave B. reported that they had cleaned eight of the wet wells and the siphon chamber in the harbor area.

New London departed the meeting at 6:30 p.m.

Board of Commissioners Meeting July 29, 2021 Sunapee Town Office Meeting Room

Also present: Holly Leonard, David Bailey, Kimberly Hallquist-New London Town Administrator, New London Selectmen-Nancy Rollins, Janet Kidder and John Cannon. April Sargent and Charley Hanson of R.M.I.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.

1. New London Sunapee Joint Meeting: See Joint Meeting Minutes.

2. Forms for Approval:

June 8, 2021 Meeting Minutes: Wayne S. made a motion to accept the June 8th minutes, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman. June 24, 2021 Meeting Minutes: Douglas G. made a motion to accept the June 24th minutes, seconded by Jimmy W., Charles H. stated that he was in attendance but is not listed as present, voted 6 in favor, 1 abstained, the motion passes in the majority, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>June Sewer Purchase Journal:</u> Douglas G. made a motion to accept the Sewer Purchase Journal for June, seconded by Charles H., after some discussion regarding Clean Waters, Atlantic Fluid Technology, and Epping Water & Sewer Department, voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>June Water Purchase Journal:</u> Douglas G. made a motion to accept the Water Purchase Journal for June, seconded by Jimmy W., after some discussion regarding Tri-state Backflow and what Eversource bills, voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>58 & 60 JAL Abatement Request:</u> After some discussion regarding the property and the fact that there has been no use there for several years, Charles H. made a motion to accept the abatement request for 58 & 60 John Avery Lane, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>2022 State Grant Acceptance:</u> After some discussion regarding the State Grant for the 1997 Water Bond, Douglas G. made a motion to accept the 2022, seconded by Richard C., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

<u>Certificate of Vote to authorize:</u> Douglas G. made a motion to approve the certificate of vote of authorization, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

3. Water Treatment Highlights:

Dave B. told the Commission that there had been a leaking hydrant in front of the Information Booth that apparently people had been getting water from unmetered, so the

department dug up the hydrant and removed it. He stated that there had also been a leak on Westwood Road and that the department is intending to replace the line this fall as it has been experiencing too many leaks. There was some discussion about the possibility of making the line year-round and Dave B. stated that he did not see that being worth the investment.

Dave B. stated that there had been a meeting today about the asset management plan and that it is moving along pretty well. Dave reported that he had met with Donna N. and Scott H. about the American Rescue Plan Act funds that had been discussed at the last meeting and that he had told them that he could use all of that grant money to hopefully bore new water lines under Route 11 at various locations and that Scott H. had agreed that this seemed like worthy projects to use the funding for.

Dave B. reported that the turbine pump that had been rebuilt is installed at River Road and is ready to be turned on when Bob Collins says to turn it on.

4. Wastewater Treatment Highlights Continued: Dave B. reported that they did get the new generator at Pump Station 9 and that they are waiting for new gas lines to be run in order to install it. He stated that Pump Station 13 is in need of some work and that one of the pumps there has been getting really loud so it is being taken to AAA Pump next week to be rebuilt. He stated that Aaron C. had proposed that they purchase pump components to have on hand so they can just slide it in when a pump needs to be pulled and that he is still waiting for that underground propane tank to be empty so that it can be dug up and replaced with an above ground one. He told the Commission that he is planning to do some building maintenance at Pump Station 13 as well because it is in need of new shingles and siding to make it look better.

5. Old & New Business:

Dave B. presented that he is losing an employee and that Stephan will be difficult to replace. There was some discussion regarding the job postings.

Holly L. presented a questionnaire from the Auditors for the Commission and went over the questions. Jimmy W. made a motion to allow Theodore G. to sign the Auditor's documents when they are filled in with the Commission's replies, seconded by Wayne S., voted unanimously in favor, so declared by the Chairman.

Updated Laborer Job Description: The Commission reviewed the updated job description and approved sending it on to the Selectmen for their approval.

Dave B. stated that he and Holly L. had discussed where to get the money from for the repair of the turbine pump and that it was decided to utilize the Water Capital Improvement Capital Reserve Fund. Charles H. made a motion to withdraw \$12,469 for the rebuilding of the pump for the turbine at River Road Pump Station from the Water Capital Improvement Capital Reserve Fund, that was established for such purposes, in accordance with RSA 38:29 III, seconded by Jimmy W., voted unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.

The next monthly meeting will be on August 26, 2021.

7:28 p.m. Douglas G. made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jimmy W., polled unanimously in the affirmative, so declared by the Chairman.
