SWIM LEVELS

Preschool Water Fun!

For our younger "beach goers" (ages 2-4) and their parents, a water adjustment class full of getting used to the water with fun and games! Parental participation is a must. We will be playing games in the water and learning some safety as well!

For Swimmers entering kindergarten and beyond...

Level 1 – Water Exploration: Skills taught include water adjustment, prone float, turning over, kicking, beginner and crawl stroke. Water adjustment is the main focus in this level.

Level 2 – Primary Skills: Prerequisite skills are those learned in level 1. Students will be introduced to elements of the front and back crawl stroke.

Level 3 – Stroke Readiness: The prerequisite is successful completion of level 2. Students will improve front and back crawl strokes and be introduced to elementary backstroke.

Level 4 – Stroke Development: Students master previously learned swimming strokes and skills. Learn the breast stroke and side stroke and learn the basics of diving.

Level 5 – Stroke Refinement: Students are introduced to the butterfly stroke and further development on diving.

Level 6 – Swimming & Skills Proficiency: Prepare for advanced courses. Personal water safety. Lifeguard readiness. Fundamentals of diving. Fitness swimmer. This class is the precursor to the lifeguarding class.

The Conservation Commission recently harvested lumber on the Town Forest at Ledge Pond. Parts

of the harvest were used to develop a new loop trail to the pond, as an alternative to the up and back trail. The loop will not be ready for hiking this year. Ledge Pond is accessed by taking a left onto Meadow Brook Rd. off of Prospect Hill Rd. It's an easy walk through the woods, ending in a view of the 110 Acre pond. The pond is a nesting area for loons. Trails have also been further developed in the Wendell Marsh area. The trail head is on the Wastewater Treatment Road, with parking available. 


