**Article 11:** Are you in favor of the Town raising and appropriating the sum of \$3,600,000 for the design, construction, equipping, and furnishing of a Public Safety building, to be erected on the site formerly occupied by the Highway Garage and Fire Station, (Sargent Road and Rt. 11, Map 25, Lots 6 & 6A), from the following sources: \$495,846 from general taxation; and up to \$3,104,154 from issuance and sale of bonds for such purposes, provided:

(1) The Board of Selectmen is authorized, in its discretion, to obtain loans in support of the project through the State of New Hampshire and from the United States Government; and

(2) The Board of Selectmen is authorized to defray a portion of the costs of the project and thereby reduce the amount to be raised from taxation and/or issuance and sale of bonds, from any and all grants-in-aid available from the United States of America or the State of New Hampshire for said purpose, acceptance of which is hereby authorized, together with authorization to incur indebtedness in anticipation of receipt of such grants-in-aid, pursuant to RSA 33:7-b. The Board of Selectmen shall determine whether the amount to be raised from taxation and/or issuance and sale of bonds may be reduced after determining the amounts available from the alternate sources specified in this and the immediately preceding paragraph. Sixty percent vote required for bonding.

Recommended by the Board of Selectmen and Budget Advisory Committee.
