COUNT OF VOTES FOR GOVERNOR OR U.S. SENATOR

- #1. "Total write-in votes" is the sum of all such votes cast separately for each office (Governor or U.S. Senator) which is on the inserted separate **Republican** "Write In Votes" form for each race. (Note: This excludes write in votes for candidates whose names were printed on the Republican ballot. Those votes should be tallied with the printed name.)
- #2. "Total Undervotes" is the sum of all ballots on which no vote was cast for each office (Governor or U.S. Senator), nor were there any write-in votes for either office. The Accuvote machine tape includes undervotes among "blanks".
- #3. "Total Overvotes" is the sum of all ballots on which more than one candidate was voted for and/or written in for each office (Governor or U.S. Senator). The Accuvote machine tape includes overvotes among "blanks".
- #4. "Contest Grand Total" is the sum of the votes cast for all candidates for each office (Governor or U.S. Senator), the total write-in votes for (Governor or U.S. Senator, whichever is applicable) and the total undervotes/overvotes for (Governor or U.S. Senator, whichever is applicable). That sum should equal (or agree with) the total of 'ELECTION DAY Official Ballots Cast' and 'ABSENTEE Official Ballots Cast' on the Ballots Cast and Names on Checklist form and the "CAST BALLOTS" number on the Label for Resealing Ballots.

NOTE: Ballots that should NOT be included in these sums are (a) the number of spoiled (cancelled) ballots and (b) any marked ballot for which the voter was challenged and the ballot was determined to be uncountable by the moderator (e.g. the voter did not sign an affidavit following a challenge).


