ARTICLES

3. Shall the District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein totaling Nine Million Six Hundred Twenty-one Thousand One Hundred Three dollars (\$9,621,103)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Nine Million Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventeen dollars (\$9,218,817), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

4. Shall the District vote to raise and appropriate up to Twenty-five Thousand dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the School District Special Education Trust Fund previously established, with such amount to be funded from the year end undesignated fund balance available on June 30, 2008?

5. Shall the District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000) and place said funds into the School Facilities Capital Reserve Fund? (A vote at an annual school district meeting is required in order to spend any funds from this capital reserve fund.)

6. Shall the district vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000) to be added to the Sunapee Central Elementary School Maintenance Capital Reserve fund previously established, with such amount to be funded from the year end undesignated fund balance available on June 30, 2008?

7. Shall the District vote to discontinue the capital reserve fund for the Food Service Program created in 2004. Said funds, with accumulated interest to day of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the school district's general fund. (Majority vote required)

8. Shall the District vote to discontinue the capital reserve fund for School Bus created in 1989. Said funds, with accumulated interest to day of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the school district's general fund. (Majority vote required)

9. Shall the District vote to authorize the treasurer, with the approval of the school board, to appoint a deputy treasurer?

Shall the district vote to establish a capital reserve fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for the purpose of establishing an SAU office, and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$150,000.00 to be placed in this fund, and further designate the Sunapee School Board as agents to expend. (Majority vote required)
