Property owners may give their Guest Pass to renters so that they have access to the Sunapee Transfer Station & Recycling Center. The permit will allow you access to the gated facility within the following operating hours:

DEWEY BEACH & GEORGES MILLS BEACH

THE BEACHES OPEN MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND AND CLOSE LABOR DAY WEEKEND.

DEWEY BEACH



158 GARNET ST, SUNAPEE, NH

Dewey Beach is open 7 days a week, with lifeguard hours from 9am-5pm.

GEORGES MILLS BEACH



18 COOPER ST, SUNAPEE, NH

Georges Mill Beach lifeguard hours are Saturday and Sunday from 11am-3pm.

Renters MUST display a Visitor/Guest Pass to park at the beaches. PASSES MUST BE LEFT AT THE PROPERTY AT THE END OF YOUR STAY!

No pass? You can also visit MT. SUNAPEE STATE PARK: 86 Beach Access Road, Newbury, NH.

- The Dewey Beach "Shed" is home to information about the beach and refreshments to purchase. Enjoy the playground, and basketball. Picnic tables, lounge chairs and umbrellas (when available) are also complimentary.
- Paddleboards and kayaks can be checked out of the Shed. Please see a Beach attendant for more information.
- Pets are not allowed at Dewey Beach or Georges Mills Beach.
- Alcohol is strictly prohibited on all Town property.

FIRE PITS & FIREWORKS

- The use of fireworks is strictly prohibited by short-term renters.
- Individual guests must seek a permit from the state for use of an outdoor wood firepit at: nh.burnsafeamerica.com/
- Use of wood firepits is allowed after 5pm
- Only clean, untreated wood sourced from New Hampshire can be burned.
 All firewood of out-of-state origin is prohibited from the state of New Hampshire unless it is labeled as certified heat-treated.

KEEP READING FOR A QUICK OVERVIEW OF EACH...

BEACHES & RECREATION AREAS

- Recreation areas include: Ben Mere Lawn & Bandstand, Dewey Beach, Georges
 Mills Beach, Coffin Park, Information Booth area, and Sunapee Harbor
- Recreation areas are CLOSED between the hours of 10 P.M. and 5 A.M.
- No person shall deposit residential trash in recreational area trash barrels or elsewhere in a recreational area except the refuse, garbage, or other material of a picnic or other permitted activity within the area.
- There shall be no swimming or playing in the water of Sunapee Harbor in recreational areas including the boat launch, Town docks, and the park area east of the Town docks.
- Renters MUST display a Visitor/Guest Pass to park at Dewey Beach, Georges
 Mills Beach, or any parking areas reserved for residents. Property owners may
 leave this pass in a central location in the rental property, or attach it to this
 handbook. PASSES MUST BE LEFT AT THE PROPERTY AT THE END OF YOUR STAY!

TOWN PROPERTIES & PETS

- There shall be no loitering or behaving in a boisterous manner. Sleeping on seats, benches, or other areas; engaging in loud, threatening, abusive, insulting, or indecent language; engaging in any disorderly conduct or behavior that breaches the public's peaceful use of Town Property.
- No camping (unless a permit is issued by the Sunapee Selectboard)
- On Town Property, animals shall be on a leash and under the control of their handlers and shall not be allowed to become a nuisance to other patrons.
- Pets (with the exception of service animals) are not allowed at Dewey Beach, Nona's Playground, or Georges Mills Beach Area.
- It is not permissible to consume alcohol on Town Property.

NOISE ORDINANCE

Thank you for respecting our Town Noise Ordinance, and for helping us maintain the peace and nighborly spirit here in Sunapee!

 Social gatherings, loud music, or other noise disturbances are prohibited during the following hours:

> Monday - Thursday: 10:00pm and 6:30am Friday & Saturday: 11:00pm and 6:30am Sundays & Holidays: 10:00pm and 8:30am

- Noise disturbances may also include unloading, opening, closing or loud handling
 of containers, trash cans or similar objects. Additionally, the ordinance prohibits
 operating a motor vehicle in a way that makes any loud, unusual or unnecessary
 noise including car horns. Please refer to the actual ordinance for a full list.
- Guests shall comply with the State of New Hampshire's disorderly conduct law (RSA644:2) and all other applicable Town ordinances and State regulations.

PARKING AREAS

PARKING MAPS ARE OUTLINED ON THE NEXT PAGES

No vehicle or trailer shall be parked in a Town Parking Lot for more than 24 hours unless otherwise posted (no overnight parking). Unregistered or abandoned vehicles may be towed at the expense of the owner.

SUMMER RESTRICTIONS (MEMORIAL DAY THROUGH COLUMBUS DAY)


- Chart 1: Lot A, C no vehicle shall be parked for longer than four (4) hours.
- Chart 1: Lot B no vehicle shall be parked for longer than six (6) hours.
- Chart 1: Lot D, E no vehicle shall be parked for longer than two (2) hours.
- At Georges Mills Harbor/Beach, three parking spaces adjacent to the boatlaunch ramp and facing the lake shall be designated for general public use and no vehicle shall be parked in these spaces for longer than twenty (20) minutes.

WINTER RESTRICTIONS (NOVEMBER 1ST THROUGH APRIL 1ST)

- During the winter parking restriction, no vehicle may be parked in any public street or way between the hours of 12:00am and 7:30am to allow for snow removal.
- During the winter parking restriction period, overnight parking will be allowed between the hours of 6:00pm and 7:30am in the following locations:
 - 1. The parking lot on the corner of Main and High Streets east of Hames Park.
 - 2. The parking lot on High Street on the south side of Sugar River.


